All goals can be achieved: you are a thinking machine; you will never rot.

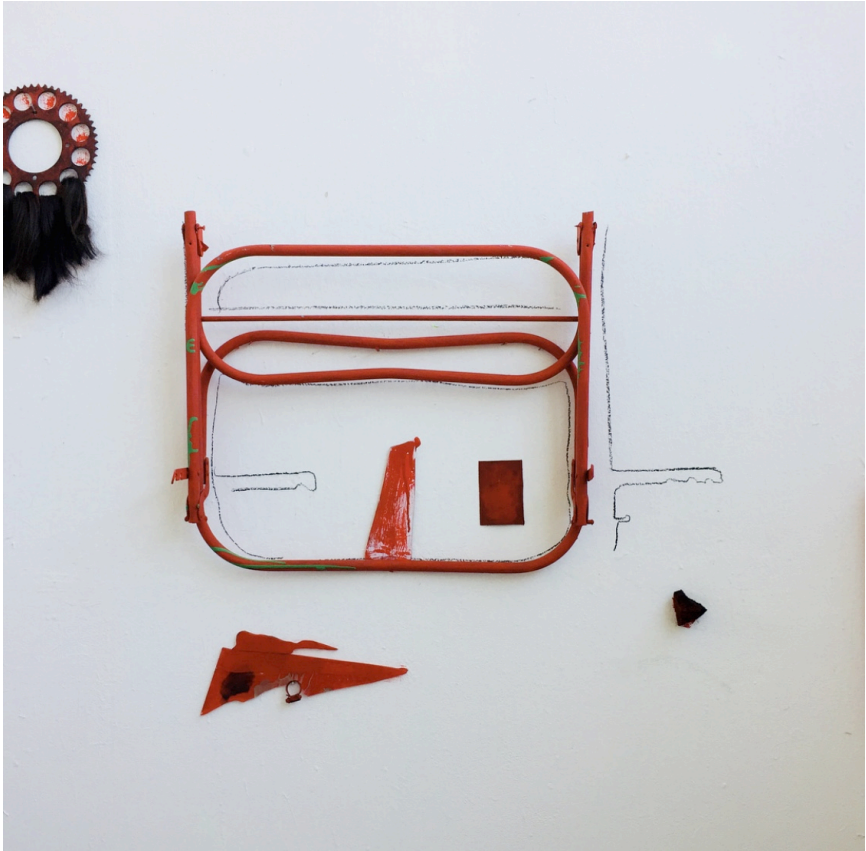
To be a *thinking* machine and to think *like* a machine are two different conditions. However, they can be combined in one person.
